What are reference materials?	Reference materials help find word meanings, pronunciations, parts of speech, and etymology.
Why use a thesaurus?	A thesaurus provides synonyms and antonyms to enhance writing.
How to find a word's etymology?	Etymology reveals a word's history and origin, aiding in deeper understanding.
Differences between print and digital dictionaries?	Print dictionaries offer tactile learning, while digital versions provide quick access and multimedia features.
