What are central ideas?	Central ideas are the main points an author makes about a topic.
How do central ideas interact?	Central ideas interact by building on each other to develop a complex analysis.
What is an objective summary?	An objective summary is a brief, unbiased restatement of the text's main
Why is analyzing central ideas important?	points.
How can you identify central ideas?	Analyzing central ideas helps in understanding the text's deeper meaning and structure.
	Identify central ideas by looking for repeated themes and key points the author emphasizes.
