Cues	Notes
What is the main idea?	Main ideas are central concepts that the text revolves around.
How do events interact?	Events interact through cause-and-effect relationships, influencing the text's progression.
What are supporting details?	Supporting details provide evidence and elaboration for the main ideas.
How do individuals influence the text?	Individuals in a text can drive the narrative or influence the development of ideas.
What is the sequence of events?	The sequence of events is the order in which things happen, which can affect understanding.
