What are democratic discussions?	Democratic discussions involve everyone having a voice and making decisions collectively.
Why are clear goals important?	Clear goals provide direction and purpose, making discussions more focused.
How can roles be assigned effectively?	Assigning roles helps distribute responsibilities and ensures active participation.
What is the impact of deadlines?	Deadlines create a sense of urgency and help keep the group on track.
How to ensure equal participation?	Using timers and structured turn-taking can help ensure everyone contributes.
