What is the standard?	The standard focuses on presenting information clearly with supporting evidence and addressing opposing viewpoints.
Why is addressing opposing viewpoints important?	Addressing opposing viewpoints shows critical thinking and strengthens the argument.
How should presentation style	
vary?	Presentation style should vary based on the audience and purpose to effectively communicate the message.
What are some real-world	
applications?	Real-world applications include delivering speeches, presenting research, and pitching ideas.
