Formal style	Formal style: Writing that follows specific conventions and uses precise language.
Objective tone	Objective tone: Presenting information fairly and without bias.
Writing conventions	Writing conventions: Rules and norms specific to different disciplines.
Common misconceptions	Misconception 1: Formal writing requires complex vocabulary.
Real-world applications	Misconception 2: Objective tone excludes personal perspective. Applications: Research papers, formal letters, business emails, technical documents, academic essays.
