Research question	Research question: Formulate a clear and focused question to guide your research.

Synthesis	Credible sources: Evaluate sources based on the author's credentials, publication date, and purpose.
Inquiry	Synthesis: Combine information from multiple sources to create a cohesive understanding or argument.
Presentation	Inquiry: Narrow or broaden your research based on the scope of your question.
	Presentation: Present your findings in a clear and organized manner, using various media if necessary.
