Adjectives	Adjectives are words that describe nouns.
What are adjectives?	Adjectives can describe people, places, things, and animals.
Examples of adjectives	Examples: happy, blue, tall, soft.
Common misconceptions	Misconception 1: Adjectives only describe people.
Real-world applications	Misconception 2: Adjectives are confused with nouns or verbs.
	Applications: Describing objects, writing sentences, playing descriptive games.
