Capitalization	Capitalization is needed at the beginning of sentences and for proper nouns.
Punctuation	
Spelling	Punctuation marks like periods, commas, and question marks clarify meaning.
Proper Nouns	Spelling words correctly helps convey the intended message.
Pronoun 'l'	Proper nouns always start with a capital letter.
	The pronoun 'I' is always capitalized.
