What is the difference between prefixes and suffixes?	Prefixes are added to the beginning of a word, while suffixes are added to the end.
Why are affixes important?	Understanding affixes helps in decoding new words and improving vocabulary.
Examples of common affixes	Common affixes include 'un-', 're-', '-ing', and '-ed'.
