Cues	Notes
What is categorization?	Categorization is grouping items based on shared characteristics.
What are key attributes?	Key attributes are important features that help define a word.
Examples of categorization	Examples: A duck is a bird that swims; a tiger is a large cat with stripes.
Common misconceptions	Misconception 1: All birds can swim. Misconception 2: All large cats have stripes.
