Cues	Notes
What is the standard?	The standard is about identifying real-life connections between words and their use.
Why are real-life connections important?	Real-life connections help students understand and remember words
important:	better.
What are some examples of real-life connections?	Examples include noting cozy places at home or identifying noisy places.
What misconceptions might students have?	Students might think words have only one use or that descriptive words aren't important.
How can we address these misconceptions?	Address misconceptions by providing multiple examples and showing the value of descriptive words.
