| Cues | Notes |
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| Phonics | Phonics involves understanding the relationship between letters and sounds. |
| Word Analysis | Word analysis skills help in breaking down words into smaller parts to understand their meaning. |
| Decoding | Decoding is the ability to apply knowledge of letter-sound relationships to correctly pronounce written words. |
| Letter Sounds | Letters can make different sounds depending on the word they are in. |
| Common Misconceptions | Common misconceptions include thinking letters always make the same sound and that only familiar words can be decoded. |
