Phonics	Phonics involves understanding the relationship between letters and sounds.
Word Analysis	
Decoding	Word analysis skills help in breaking down words into smaller parts to understand their meaning.
Letter Sounds	Decoding is the ability to apply knowledge of letter-sound relationships to correctly pronounce written words.
Common Misconceptions	Letters can make different sounds depending on the word they are in.
	Common misconceptions include thinking letters always make the same sound and that only familiar words can be decoded.
