#### Today's Standard

Cues	Notes
What is final -e?	Final -e makes the vowel say its name, as in 'make'.
What are vowel teams?	Vowel teams are pairs of vowels that create a long vowel sound, like 'ea' in 'team'.
Examples of long vowel sounds?	Examples: 'cake', 'team', 'boat'.
Common misconceptions?	Misconception: All words ending in 'e' have a long vowel sound.
How to practice long vowel sounds?	Practice with games, reading, and sorting activities.
