



## Contextual Word Recognition

Cues	Notes
What is context?	Context refers to the words and sentences around a particular word that help clarify its meaning.
Why is rereading important?	Rereading helps improve comprehension and allows students to catch details they may have missed the first time.
How can context help with word recognition?	Context can provide clues about the meaning of unfamiliar words, helping readers make more accurate guesses.
What is a common misconception about word guessing?	Some students think they can guess a word based on its first letter, but this often leads to mistakes.
What is a common misconception about rereading?	Some students believe they only need to read a sentence once to understand it, but rereading can enhance understanding.
