Cues	Notes
Key details	Key details are important pieces of information in a story.
Characters	Characters are the people or animals in the story.
Setting	Setting is where and when the story takes place.
Major events	Major events are the big happenings in the story.
Who, what, where, when, why	Asking 'who, what, where, when, why' helps identify key details.
