Cues	Notes
Discussion rules	Following discussion rules helps everyone participate and understand.
Active listening	Active listening means paying attention and thinking about what is being said.
Taking turns	Taking turns ensures everyone has a chance to speak.
Visual cues	Taking turns ensures everyone has a chance to speak.
Cummorizina	Visual cues like a talking stick help manage turn-taking.
Summarizing	Summarizing what others say shows you are listening and helps clarify ideas.
