Cues	Notes
What is active listening?	Active listening means paying full attention to the speaker.
Why ask questions?	Asking questions helps gather more information and clarify doubts.
How to ask good questions?	Good questions are relevant and related to the topic.
Examples of good questions.	Examples: 'What happened next in the story?', 'Can you explain that again?'
