| What is a complete sentence?                    | A complete sentence has a subject and a predicate and expresses a complete thought.           |
| Why are complete sentences important?           | Complete sentences are important for clear communication and understanding.                   |
| How do you form a complete sentence?            | To form a complete sentence, include a subject (who or what) and a predicate (what about it). |
| What are common mistakes in sentence formation? | Common mistakes include using fragments and overly long sentences.                            |
| How can you improve sentence clarity?           | Improving sentence clarity involves balancing detail and conciseness.                         |
