important?	Complete sentences are important for clear communication and understanding.
How do you form a complete	
sentence?	To form a complete sentence, include a subject (who or what) and a predicate (what about it).
What are common mistakes in	
sentence formation?	Common mistakes include using fragments and overly long sentences.
How can you improve sentence clarity?	Improving sentence clarity involves balancing detail and conciseness.
