Cues	Notes
Shared research	Shared research involves working together to gather information on a topic.
Writing projects	Writing projects can include creating guides, stories, or reports.

Sequencing	Sequencing is important to ensure steps are followed in the correct order.
Collaboration	Collaboration helps students learn from each other and share ideas.
