What are spelling patterns?	Spelling patterns are rules that help us spell words correctly.
Why are spelling patterns important?	They are important because they help us write and read more easily. An example is changing 'cage' to 'badge' or 'boy' to 'boil'.
What is an example of a spelling pattern?	Some students think all similar-sounding words follow the same pattern, but this is not true.
What are common misconceptions about spelling patterns?	We can practice by writing sentences, reading books, and playing spelling games.
How can we practice spelling patterns?
