What are common misconceptions?	Misconception 1: All descriptive words are interchangeable.
How can we address misconceptions?	Misconception 2: Descriptive words only apply to physical objects.
misconceptions:	Intervention 1: Use examples and non-examples to clarify word usage.
	Intervention 2: Provide diverse examples, including feelings and actions.
