What are adjectives?	Adjectives describe nouns (e.g., happy, blue, tall).
What are adverbs?	Adverbs describe verbs, adjectives, or other adverbs (e.g., quickly, very, well).
How do adjectives and adverbs differ?	Adjectives and adverbs serve different purposes in sentences.
Why is descriptive language important?	Descriptive language makes writing more vivid and engaging.
How can we use descriptive words effectively?	Use adjectives and adverbs to add detail, but avoid overuse.
