Why is measurement

What tools are used for	
measurement?	Rulers and measuring tapes are common tools for measuring length.
Common misconceptions?	Visual estimation can be misleading; students may think they can estimate differences without measuring.
How to correct misconceptions?	
	Use rulers to measure and compare, emphasizing precision and hands-on practice.
