2.MD.C7 - Tell and write time from analog and digital clocks to the nearest five minutes, using a.m. and p.m.

Cues	Notes
What is the difference between the hour and minute hands?	The hour hand is shorter and points to the hour. The minute hand is longer and points to the minutes.
How do you read time to the nearest five minutes?	To read time to the nearest five minutes, look at where the minute hand is pointing and count by fives.
What is the difference between a.m. and p.m.?	a.m. is the time from midnight to noon, and p.m. is the time from noon to midnight.

Summary

Understanding how to read and write time from analog and digital clocks to the nearest five minutes, and knowing the difference between a.m. and p.m., are essential skills for time management.
