Why is understanding hundreds important?	Understanding hundreds is crucial for grasping place value and performing arithmetic with larger numbers.
What are common misconceptions?	Common misconceptions include thinking 100 is just a large number and confusing tens with hundreds.
How can we correct misconceptions?	Use visual aids, manipulatives, and repetitive practice to correct misconceptions.
