What is place value?	Place value refers to the value of a digit based on its position in a number.
How do you write numbers in expanded form?	Writing numbers in expanded form means breaking them down into their individual place values.
What are base-ten numerals?	Base-ten numerals are the standard numerical system we use, consisting of digits 0-9.
How do you read large numbers?	Reading large numbers involves understanding the value of each digit based on its place.
Why is this skill important?	This skill is important for performing arithmetic operations and solving real-world problems.
