Cues	Notes
Place value	Place value helps determine the value of each digit in a number.
Comparing numbers	Three-digit numbers are compared by looking at the hundreds, tens, and ones places.
Symbols $>$, $=$, $<$	The symbols $>$, $=$, and $<$ are used to show which number is greater, equal, or less.
