Cues	Notes
Place value	Place value helps in understanding the value of digits based on their position.
Regrouping	Regrouping is used when the sum or difference in a column exceeds 9.
Order of operations	Following the correct order of operations is crucial in multi-step
Addition strategies	problems.
Subtraction strategies	Addition strategies include counting on, making ten, and using number lines.
	Subtraction strategies include counting back, finding the difference, and using number lines.
