Adding multiple two-digit numbers

Cues	Notes
What is place value?	Place value refers to the value of each digit in a number based on its position.
How do you add two-digit	
numbers?	To add two-digit numbers, align them by place value and add from right to left.
What is a carry-over in	
addition?	A carry-over occurs when the sum of digits in a column exceeds 9, and the extra value is carried to the next column.
Why is aligning numbers	
important?	Aligning numbers by place value ensures accurate addition.
What strategies help in adding multiple numbers?	Using visual aids, step-by-step examples, and practice problems can help in adding multiple numbers.
