Cues	Notes
What are key ideas?	Key ideas are the main points or themes of a text or presentation.
How to recount a story?	Recounting a story involves retelling the main events in order.
What details should be included?	Include important details that support the main ideas.
Difference between key ideas and minor details?	Key ideas are the main points; minor details add extra information but are not essential.

Summary

Understanding key ideas and details helps students comprehend and retell information accurately, focusing on the main points rather than every single detail.
