## Today's Standard

Cues	Notes
Clarifying questions	Clarifying questions help understand better.
Active listening	Active listening involves paying full attention to the speaker.
Relevant questions	Questions should be relevant to the topic.
Gathering information	Asking questions can gather more information.
Deepening understanding	Questions can deepen understanding of the topic.
