What are common misconceptions about complete sentences?	Common misconceptions include thinking any sentence is acceptable and that sentence length determines completeness.
How can we practice using complete sentences?	Practice through sentence completion exercises, group discussions, storytelling, role-playing, and peer review.
What will we learn after mastering this standard?	After mastering this standard, students will use more complex sentences and vocabulary, improving their communication skills.
