What is shared research?	Shared research involves working together to gather and write about information from multiple sources. Collaboration helps combine different strengths and ideas, making the project better. Paraphrasing means putting information into your own words while keeping the original meaning. Roles in a group project are different tasks assigned to each member based on their strengths.
