What are regular verbs?	Regular verbs form their past tense by adding -ed.
What are irregular verbs?	Irregular verbs do not follow a consistent pattern for past tense.
Examples of regular verbs	Examples of regular verbs: walk-walked, jump-jumped.
Examples of irregular verbs	Examples of irregular verbs: go-went, buy-bought.
Why is this important?	Understanding verb forms improves writing and speaking skills.

Summary
