What is subject-verb agreement?	Subject-verb agreement means the subject and verb in a sentence must match in number.
What is pronoun-antecedent agreement?	Pronoun-antecedent agreement means the pronoun must match the antecedent in number and gender.
Why is agreement important?	Agreement is important for clarity and grammatical correctness.
How can you identify the subject of a sentence?	The subject is the main noun that the sentence is about; it performs the action of the verb.
What are common errors in agreement?	Common errors include mismatching singular and plural forms, and using the wrong gender pronoun.
