Proper Capitalization in Titles

What are the rules for capitalizing titles?	Capitalize the first and last words in a title.
Which words should be capitalized in a title?	Capitalize all major words, including nouns, pronouns, verbs, adjectives, and adverbs.
What are common misconceptions about	Do not capitalize articles, conjunctions, and prepositions unless they are the first or last words in the title.
capitalizing titles?	Common misconceptions include capitalizing every word and forgetting to capitalize important words like 'is' and 'the'.

Summary

Properly capitalizing titles involves capitalizing the first and last words, as well as all major words. Common misconceptions include over-capitalizing and missing important words.
