Cues	Notes
What is spatial vocabulary?	Spatial vocabulary refers to words that describe locations and positions.
What is temporal vocabulary?	Temporal vocabulary includes words that indicate time and sequence.
Why is domain-specific vocabulary important?	Domain-specific vocabulary helps students understand and communicate within specific subjects.
Examples of spatial words?	Spatial words: above, below, beside, between.
Examples of temporal words?	Temporal words: before, after, during, while.
