Phonics	Phonics involves understanding the sounds that letters and combinations of letters make.
Word Analysis	
Decoding	Word analysis skills help students break down words into smaller parts to understand their meaning.
Sight Words	Decoding is the ability to apply knowledge of letter-sound relationships to correctly pronounce written words.
Fluency	Sight words are common words that do not always follow standard phonetic rules and must be memorized.
	Fluency is the ability to read text accurately, quickly, and with proper expression.
