Cues	Notes
Prefixes	Prefixes are added to the beginning of a word to change its meaning.
Suffixes	Suffixes are added to the end of a word to change its meaning.
Root Words	Root words are the main part of the word that gives the basic meaning.
Examples	Examples: 'un-' in 'unhappy', '-ful' in 'joyful'.
Why Important?	Understanding prefixes and suffixes helps in decoding unfamiliar words and expands vocabulary.
