## Latin Suffixes Decoding

| Cues                                  | Notes   |
|---------------------------------------|---|
| What are Latin suffixes?              | Latin suffixes are endings added to root words to change their meaning.   |
| How do suffixes change word meanings? | Suffixes can turn a noun into an adjective (e.g., 'joy' to 'joyful').   |
| What are common suffixes?             | Common suffixes include -ful, -less, -ness, -ment, and -tion.   |
| How do you spell words with suffixes? | Spelling rules: drop the final 'e' (e.g., 'make' to 'making'), double the final consonant (e.g., 'run' to 'running'). |
