Cues	Notes
What is decoding?	Decoding is breaking down words into smaller parts to read them.
Why are multisyllabic words important?	Multisyllabic words are important for reading longer and more complex texts.
What are common misconceptions?	Common misconceptions include thinking longer words can't be broken down and that all syllables are pronounced equally.
How can we decode multisyllabic words?	We can decode multisyllabic words by identifying prefixes, suffixes, and root words, and by understanding syllable stress.
What skills are needed before learning this?	Students need to know how to decode single-syllable words and understand basic phonics patterns.
