Cues	Notes
What are text features?	Text features include titles, headings, captions, etc.
How do you use keywords?	Keywords help narrow down searches to find specific information.
Why are sidebars important?	Sidebars provide additional information related to the main text.
What is a hyperlink?	Hyperlinks are clickable links that lead to more information.
How to evaluate online information?	Evaluate online information by checking the author, date, and cross-referencing.
