## Today's Standard

Cues	Notes
What is the main idea?	The main idea is the central point of the text.
How do sentences connect?	Sentences connect through logical relationships like cause/effect, comparison, and sequence.
What is a topic sentence?	A topic sentence introduces the main idea of a paragraph.
What are supporting details?	Supporting details provide evidence or examples that back up the topic
How do paragraphs connect?	sentence.
	Paragraphs connect through transitions and logical sequencing.
