Cues	Notes
Point of view	Point of view: The perspective from which a story is told.
Narrator	Narrator: The person or character telling the story.
Character perspective	Character perspective: The unique viewpoint of each character based on their experiences and role in the story.
Compare viewpoints	Compare viewpoints: Analyzing how different perspectives in a story can change the reader's understanding.
Empathy in literature	Empathy in literature: Understanding and appreciating the feelings and viewpoints of others through reading.
