Cues	Notes
Capitalization	Capitalization is the use of uppercase letters at specific places in writing.
Proper Nouns	Proper nouns, such as names of people, places, and specific things, should always be capitalized.
First Word in Sentence	
Pronoun 'l'	The first word of every sentence needs to be capitalized.
Common Nouns	The pronoun 'I' should always be capitalized, regardless of its position in a sentence.
	Common nouns are not capitalized unless they are at the start of a sentence.
