What are context clues?	Context clues are hints found within a text that help readers understand the meaning of unfamiliar words.
Why is rereading important?	
	Rereading helps confirm understanding and clarify meanings.
How can context help with	
word recognition?	Context provides additional information that aids in recognizing and understanding words.
Examples of context clues.	
·	Examples include definitions, synonyms, antonyms, and explanations
Common misconceptions about context clues.	within the text.
	Misconceptions include thinking context clues are only in the same sentence and viewing rereading as a failure.
