Comprehending Informational Texts

Cues	Notes
Main Idea	Main Idea: The central point or message of a text.
Supporting Details	Supporting Details: Information that explains or supports the main idea.
Text Complexity	Text Complexity: The level of challenge a text presents to the reader.
Reading Strategies	Reading Strategies: Techniques used to understand and analyze texts.
